

A "Gentle" Reminder



Dear NWUP members and friends;

Great News! We will return to the sanctuary on Sunday, October 18th. Service will begin at 9:45 a.m., with the prelude and announcements.


The State of Washington and Benton-Franklin Health District have upgraded Benton County to Modified Phase 1 status for the COVID-19 response. We want everyone to stay healthy and limit the possible spread of the virus, so please read through the following modifications.

- We are limited to fifty (50) people inside the sanctuary.
- If your temperature is 100.4° F or greater, stay home.
- Please maintain a six (6) foot distance between individuals (not in the same household) at all times.
- All people 5 years old and over must wear masks. The mask must remain in place, covering your mouth and nose, throughout the service (including when singing hymns). You may remove it when taking communion.
- A <u>Greeter/Deacon</u> will log all people attending (for possible contact tracing). They will provide masks if you forgot to bring one and will have hand sanitizer available. They will also hand out bulletins and communion elements in the narthex before you enter the sanctuary.
- The pastor, worship leaders, and elders may remove their face coverings when directly addressing the congregation from the pulpit and communion table.
- Please sit in the pews in designated locations. Family units (members of the same household) may sit together.
 Deacons will indicate where you may sit.
- All pew bibles and hymnals will be removed, since they
 cannot be sanitized properly. Hymns will be displayed on
 the screen in front of the sanctuary. You may bring your
 own bible to the service for personal use.
- When using the restrooms, please allow a six-foot distance for people to leave. Hand sanitizer is available in the restrooms

- At the end of the service, please wait in your pew and a <u>Greeter/Deacon</u> will indicate when you may leave.
- After the service, if you wish to talk to members not in your household, please maintain the six-foot distancing and/or continue to wear your mask.
- Currently, we will not have coffee hour after service or in-person Sunday School before service.


If you have any questions about returning to the sanctuary, please call the church office. Thank you for your support and welcome back to church services inside Northwest United Protestant Church.

SOCIAL CONCERNS PROJECT: OCT. 4-NOV. 8 Operation Christmas Child

For nearly 3 decades, Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes filled with gifts have been collected and delivered to children overseas. Each box filled with gifts brightens the life of a child and shares the Good News of Christ with children and their families. The NWUP Social Concerns Commission wants to share these gifts of hope with as many children as possible. If you would like to participate in this holiday project, here is some information:

- * Please pick up a shoebox (or two) beginning in October, at the church after worship or during office hours (8-12).
- * **Do not use your regular shoeboxes**, they are not sturdy enough and are difficult to ship.
- * Instructions and examples of what to pack are included in the shoeboxes. Fill boxes with toys, school supplies, and hygiene items for a boy or girl. Write the gender and the age range on the cutout labels provided. A personal note or picture will make it special.
- * The cost of items for the box is approximately \$20. (Example: a small ball, a toothbrush, colored pencils, a bar of soap, will be appreciated.) You may spend less or more, but figure this into your decision on the number of boxes you commit to.
- * You are also asked to pay the \$9 shipping fee for each box. Payment envelopes are in the boxes. Online payment is also an option.
- * Return the box to the church by Nov. 8.

Once filled and labeled, we will deliver the boxes on the assigned days to a local designated collection site. Take as many boxes as you wish but remember that each box taken is your commitment to fill and return it.


We send our love and God Speed in this new move. Add to this armloads of thank you's from all of us.
