A "GENTLE" REMINDER

Dear NWUP members and friends,

Christmas day and the joys of the season are almost here. In joyful and hectic anticipation, we want to "haul out the holly" (to quote one my favorite Christmas songs), put "candles in the window" and play "carols at the spinet." But before we "slice up the fruit cake" and "deck the halls again now", let's take a moment to breathe, to pause, and prepare our hearts. Advent, the weeks leading up to Christmas, is the season of pause and preparation. What are we preparing for? In Luke 3, the gospel writer tells of one who prepared the way for Jesus, crying out for all to get ready for Jesus. John the Baptist, in the style of Old Testament prophets, challenged the people of his time to prepare for a new way of being and a new way of knowing God. This is our challenge too. We must pause the decorations, the purchasing, the busy-ness of our commercialized Christmas and make room for a thoughtful self -examination of our own faith and our beliefs and how we make (or don't make) this world a better place for all. I believe that is what John the Baptist meant when he, quoting another Old Testament prophet, Isaiah, challenged those early listeners of Luke's gospel. "...the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God." (Luke 3:5-6)

All the new winter hats, gloves and mittens of all sizes will be donated to World Relief.




ZOOM BIBLE STUDY
